The AGMA Relief Fund Trustees have announced that the AGMA Relief Fund will temporarily double the cap of financial assistance available to AGMA members in need. Through March 31, due to the devastating toll COVID-19 has taken on our members, the maximum amount has increased to \$2,000 (basic living has increased to \$1,500, medical assistance is now up to \$2,000). AGMA hopes this will help to alleviate the dire financial straits our members now face in the wake of the coronavirus pandemic.

Any AGMA member in good standing, or on honorable withdrawal, is entitled and encouraged to apply for financial assistance through the AGMA Relief Fund. Please visit agmarelief.org to begin the application process. Grants are awarded on a case-by-case basis, based on need.
