AGMA is aware that [Columbia Artists Management Inc. \("CAMI"\)](#), one of the leading agencies representing classical music performers, [recently announced](#) that it is disbanding. Please know that AGMA is following this development closely.

If you are currently signed with CAMI or have contracts previously negotiated by CAMI, you may face multiple issues based on the closure. As you know, AGMA, your union, is the collective bargaining representative for members at each of our signatory employers and does not serve as an agent for individual members. However, the union is here to help you through this difficult period.
